**Sub: Request for initiation of water conservation work and promotion
of water-efficient methods of farming in Khoyrasole block.**

You are aware that Birbhum is one of the driest districts in the state with most of the 19 blocks suffering from irregular and inadequate rainfall. 2022 monsoons saw about 1/3 of the average annual rainfall. Several regions of the blocks can manage only single cropping. Thus a large section of the farming population has to look for other sources of income while hectares of land remains unused.

We are cognizant of the work you are doing in Rajnagar, one of the blocks that suffer from a perpetual shortage of water for irrigation. We understand you have been able to create systems for water conservation and promote water-efficient methods of farming alongwith alternative livelihoods that can supplement income for the targeted families.


In this regard, we would like to request you consider the Khoyrasole block to initiate a similar project. This block is also situated within the arid zone of Birbhum where lack of adequate rainfall, waterbodies, water retention capacity of the soil, and lack of prevalence of water-efficient methods of farming practised by the population lead to extremely low levels of farming and inadequate income.

In Khoyrasole even through the total cultivable land area is 21980 hectares, the actual cultivation data is as follows:

- Pre-kharif season: 1900 hectares
- Kharif-season: 20038 hectares
- Rabi-season: 5400 hectares

We believe, a replication of your Rajnagar model can make year-long farming possible in Khoyrasole.
