## Phuljhuri

Crèches in the Tea Estates of Jalpaiguri and in urban setup at New Town Rajarhat benefitting the tender age children of tea garden workers and construction workers with Early Childhood Care and Development services.

## Jeevan Path

Rebuilding school education that dismantled in the pandemic. Local youth leaders Trained and engaged in bringing back children to school education (children who left school during pandemic and lockdown) and facilitating regular special classes at school towards recovering the learning loss of children caused by closure of schools during pandemic.

## Surakshita Shaishab

Ensuring child protection through leadership of local youth. They along with the village and ward level child protection committee will track the child labour, child trafficking, child marriage and combat those situations activating the child protection services of the government. They also map the vulnerable children and facilitate preventive measures to be taken by the system.

## Skill Training for Youth
