About Organization

Since 2014 Garden Reach Institute For The Rehabilitation And Research has started project day Care Special school and Rehabilitation Centre to cater to the needs of cerebral palsy, mentally challenged, Multiple Disability and Autism children from slum areas of Kolkata Garden Reach Metiabruz Slums. GRIRR is working here to achieve the goal of 100% elimination of Illiteracy, alleviation of poverty, to create self-independence through rehabilitations services. The only one of its kind in Metiabruz, a Kolkata pocket comprising of a population of more than 16 lakhs.

ABOUT THE PROPOSAL

The proposal seeks grant for implementation of underprivileged child education project through establishment of 5 community based learning centers in 5 communities in ward no 134.and 80 . The suggested places where there is urgent need to start learning centers is Garden Reach ,Kolkata District in West Bengal, These slums areas have extremely low underprivileged child literacy levels. The proposal will be implemented by GARDEN REACH INSTITUTE FOR THE REHABILITATION AND RESEARCH through an NGO partner/ partners. These 5 Learning centers will impart primary education to about 200 previously out-of-school underprivileged children . The aim of the project is to provide high quality primary education to these underprivileged child and then mainstream them firmly in upper primary education. All this will be done through active participation of the parents and community members. A large number of children , especially from beggars families and daily wages workers , other backward communities who are not getting their rightful place in primary education, will be benefited.

SOCIO - ECONOMIC BACKGROUND:

During the post-independence period, the Government of India has given dues tress on increasing the Agricultural produce and its productivity by increasing the net sown area and cropping intensity. Agriculture contributes approximately one fifth (22%) of total gross domestic product. It provides



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livelihood support to about two third of the country's population and employment to 58.4% of country's work force which is the single largest private sector occupation. It also accounts 10% of total export earnings. Above all agriculture is the only source of food security for the nation. So fostering rapid and sustained agricultural growth remained a priority agenda of the government. Agriculture is to be the core element of the 10th five year plan. The net sown area has been increased from 1187.5 thousand ha in 1950-51 to 1409.6 thousand ha in 1999-2000. The Indian agriculture sector has crossed many milestones from import of food grains to export of the surplus food grains despite of increase in its population more than three folds (INDIA, 2007).

Factories strikes and lockouts are some of the very few reasons responsible for the poor socio economic background. Since this area is a part of one the ,most prime industrial zones of kolkata city and also the Garden Reach and Metaburuz area thus ,most of the population depended for their daily bread on the various direct and ancillary activities related to these rickshaw puller tea and snacks shale . Steel industries are closing down due to government policies and the activities of the various unions existing in these factories. The port has been silting up, making navigation from south 24 paraganas and North 24 paraganas down to see steadily more difficult and limiting size of sea that can use the port. Thus the authorities are decreasing their manpower and as a result of this several household are unable to make both ends meet.

The main occupation of the persons living in the community comprise of Factory workers, Tailoring, kite making and selling small swatches in the local HAATS or markets and doing hand embroidery and cardboard box manufacturing. Due to localizing of manpower and lack of specialized labour the skills of these persons are exploited to the utmost level by the big players of the game and as a result of this they earn far below their actual capacity.

Another major and existing reasons which is a hurdle to any form of developmental reforms which may be introduced in those areas are the cultural differences among the immigrant Muslims and the Hindus Muslims community living there. These differences among the masses have taken a very gigantic shape so much so that people belonging to one community do not



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want to even work with the members of the other community .All these and many more common causes like illiteracy ,Polygamy etc are responsible for the prevailing poverty in these areas and, as we know – disability and poverty go hand in hand

MAJOR CONCERNS One of the major concerns related to the underprivileged children in this region is education and protection. With a number of families that fall below the poverty line, young girls and women become the unfortunate targets. As we can see the high drop-out rate in the primary schools is a cause and symptom for the vulnerability of girls. As mentioned above many young girls are lured to the cities by agencies to work in menial jobs and as domestic workers. This is aggravated in the absence of schooling.

Brief Project Description:

Education can change the lives of underprivileged children education is a powerful tools which empowers communities to turn around their lives .if any members of family is educated , especially women, it can help coming generation to break the inter-generation cycles of poverty.

Summary

We are Located in Garden Reach district ,Kolkata of West Bengal since 2015 .We have so far worked with children with disabilities in Garden Reach ,Metaburuz in ward no 133 to 141 wards, With the support and encouragement of local community of Garden Reach ,We started community education program for underprivileged children in 2022 .We always aimed to provide affordable education to children in Garden Reach and surrounding 10 slums.

Challenge

The underprivileged children of Garden Reach are currently burdened with major issues like child labour, undernourishment ,lack of shelter , education ,and hygiene. More than 50% India's children are malnourished and 50% of Indian children ages 6-18 do not go to school.17 million children in India work as per official estimates . These children have a bleak future with no opportunity to learn and succeed in life as no many of them don't have place they can call home.

Solution

This project identifies children in need and provides them with their basic needs in order for them to succeed. They get a chance to attend a quality school that teacher ,prepares , and encourages them to realize their dreams and pursue promising careers. They also receive after -school tutoring if extra academic help is needed .In addition to an education ,children who are in most need may also receive assistance for food , shelter and basic supplies to ensure they are cared for .

Long Term Impact

This project will help 200 poor children receive a good education for a whole year. Children who would likely grow up illiterate, oppressed ,and stuck in extreme poverty will have to chance to rise up and become resourceful contributors to their society . older students who have been help through this project have moved on to pursue higher education and now enjoy careers in



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teaching ,nursing , counselling ,computers and various trade so they can give back to the community in meaningful ways.
